Just a brief update on our new Union Building in Aiea. So far, we have received the design and development prints and will have future meetings to prepare for the permitting process.

A reminder, if you become unemployed as an active member, you will need to sign in on the **Out-Of-Work List** and turn in your approved unemployment determination letter information to the **Trust Fund Administrative Office**. This benefit was created so you can qualify for **35 hours credit** to maintain your **medical coverage**. No other union has this unique benefit for its members.

On Sunday, September 1st, we had our annual Hawaii Building & Construction Trades Labor Unity Picnic at the Waikiki Shell. It was a huge success, and we had a lot of members and their families in attendance enjoying this free event. Mahalo to Brother **Sam Barrett, Jr.** who spearheaded Local 675's participation with assistance from our Union staff, Training staff, Brother **Jonathan Lee**, and the Retiree Club.

Politically, we're gearing up for the General Election on November 5th. I am working closely with our

Urgent Care

Save time and money by choosing the right care options. Emergency room visits are expensive and should only be used when you have life-threatening symptoms. There is a 10% coinsurance (amount you will need to pay out-of-pocket) that applies for each visit and emergency room visits charge the highest fee. The following are the care options available to you:

- Primary Care Provider See your primary care provider (PCP) for routine and common medical issues like fever, minor symptoms of the flu or a cold, chronic condition management, medication refills or general care.
- Urgent Care Providers Go to an urgent care provider when you need care in person sooner than you can see your doctor. Urgent care is a more cost-effective option for situations that aren't emergencies but still require medical care.
- Emergency Room Go to the emergency room when you have serious, life-threatening symptoms.


